From the Golf Course.....

On March 2, 2021, members of The Middlefork Audubon Society visited the Danville Country Club property. They were entirely impressed with the way the Bluebird nest box program is operated and monitored. A big thanks to the DCC Member volunteers who have worked on this over the years. DCC has over 20 boxes on the property. These nesting sites are vital to the survival and recovery of the Blue Bird species. During the golf season the Bluebirds feed on insects!

The Audubonites were equally pleased to see the wildlife habitat provided by our property in the wooded plots and unmaintained areas. Members of Middlefork Audubon observed numerous species of native birds that day and would like to return to conduct species inventory on May 1st and May 8th.

Wildlife siting so far this March include Red Ear Slider turtles, Wild Turkeys, and the American White Pelicans (9-foot wingspan) have flown over the golf course to land across the street in Lake Vermilion.

Oh Yes, GOLF! Please come out and enjoy the golf course. We have already cut the grass on greens, tees, and fairways in Mid-March and see things greening up a little ahead of usual.
