From the Golf Course.....

Greetings from the golf course grounds staff:

We love to see people enjoying the golf course.

We survived a long, hot spell from late June through most of July with some very timely rains.

We appreciate players who fill divots and fix ball marks on the greens. We have noticed a significant amount of unrepaired ball marks on the greens. The golf shop now has complimentary repair tools for that.

Agronomy note: Sections of the playing surfaces have “hydrophobic soils”. A phenomenon in the soil chemistry prevents precipitation or irrigation from infiltrating/ percolating down past the grass to the roots. The localized dry spots appear about a foot in diameter. A soil probe can hardly be pushed down in these spots into the crusty, dry soil but only a few inches away the probe can be inserted into the soil 12” deep and the core shows ideal soil moisture. We apply “wetting agents” to try to alleviate this so that we are not overwatering 80 % of the areas just to try and keep 20% alive. While many golf courses address Localized Dry Spot, professionals in the industry are stumped at the severity of it in our soils.
