With the help of our manager's, we have started working on several projects that we feel will help Danville Country Club provide a better overall experience. These items include:

- Establishing a new Point of Sale System for the entire club as to allow members to access all information with either a computer, phone, or tablet. We want to be able to provide online ordering, online reservations, a calendar of events, and many other functions that will streamline all aspects of DCC.
- All managers have provided questions for a survey that was sent out last month to get everyone's opinion of what is wanted or needed to improve DCC.
- We have established a new membership program that is already continuing to increase the membership numbers and will hopefully get our current membership to over 300 members. Since the beginning of the 2021 calendar year, we are up 35+ new members and rising which is the highest it has been in several year. - We are currently working on a new Locker Inventory and will have names on the lockers by the end of September for those of you that haven't had a name plate to date. If you still need a plate and haven't already spoken to me let me know so I can get one ordered.
- With the help of the Board of Directors we have established a five-year Capital Program. The capital money we are now raising will soon be used in future projects, and all members will be able to start seeing significant improvements to all entities. Please keep in mind that there are certain capital needs that will take precedent over others, but we will continue to monitor all entities throughout and decide what is best for DCC.
- We are finalizing a new Members Handbook with current by-laws, rules, regulations & roster.
- Finally, we are continuing to work on improving your overall experience here at the club. We have made improvements to the wait staff and bartending staff, we have tried to improve wait times and overall experience in the dining areas, we are



continuing to improve the lunch, dinner, and brunch menus, and we are going to start improving the overall aesthetics of the clubhouse.

FROM THE GOLF COURSE,

We went the entire 2020 season at DCC without bunker rakes in the traps because of restrictions associated with the virus. This season we have bunker rakes distributed. Please use the rakes after bunker shots and place the rakes back in the sand. Golf Professionals and maintenance personnel agree that rakes belong in the sand, not in the grass.

USGA-funded research shows that using the "lined" or "striped" divot pattern at the practice tee will contribute to speedy turf recovery and allow us to maintain a level tee. Our golf professionals can point out the proper divot patterns, but there are also signs on the practice tee that show the desired divot pattern. Please place the ball behind the original divot, and continue this in a straight line while practicing. When the divot stripe reaches 2 feet long start another divot line 6 inches over and parallel with the first line. The picture included can be used as a reference.

Finally, the golf shop provides free ball mark repair tools for all members and guests and can show golfers the proper way to repair a ball mark on the green.
