## From the Golf Course.....

From the Golf Course Superintendent:

I have been asked about repairing divots in the fairways and tees. In the Spring and Autumn when temperatures are mild and moisture is adequate, the patch of grass that has been removed by a shot can be placed back in the void. It has a chance of growing back under those conditions. During the summer and dry conditions sand can be placed in the void at or below the surface level. Sand is provided on the golf carts and at the par 3 tees in boxes. Overfilled divots are detrimental to the mowing equipment, see photo. In order to maintain our fairway and tee turf at the ½” height we use reel mowers (rotary mowers like homeowners use cannot achieve close cuts). If the reel has to cut through a “pile” of sand it will make it dull or even throw off the height of cut. This causes extra maintenance on the machine and cuts down the “life” of the reel. Our precision mowing equipment for greens, tees and fairways is very expensive and requires intensive labor. Much of the winter months are spent reconditioning the reel cutting units.

We see that many golfers are following the recommendation to take strips of divots at the practice tee. We encourage all those using the practice tee to follow this. This allows us to keep the tee level and speeds up grass recovery.
